## Beezzzzz Bracelet

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## You Need:

For a bracelet of about $6^{\prime \prime}(17 \mathrm{~cm})$ without a clasp


61 honeycomb beads (HC)
ح 218 o beads ( 0 )
72 Super Duo beads (SD)

## Clasp

\#12 beading needle
KO thread


1
Pick up 5 HC and pass back through the second hole of the last HC you picked up.


2
Pick up 10,1 SD, and 10 . Skip the next HC of the previous row and pass through the second hole of the next HC. Pick up $1 \mathrm{O}, 1 \mathrm{SD}$, and 1 O . Skip the next HC of the previous row and pass through the second hole of the next HC of the previous row. Pick up 10 and 1 SD and pass back through the second hole of the SD.

Pick up $10,1 \mathrm{HC}, 10$ and pass through the second hole of the SD you added in the previous row. Repeat this one more time. End picking up 1 O, 1 HC, 1 O, and 1 SD


4
Pass back through the second hole of the last SD you added in the previous step. Pick up 1 O. Pass through the second hole of the HC of the previous row. Follow the thread path as drawn in picture 4, to make sure your needle is at the right point to start the next row.


Repeat step 2, 3 and 4 till your bracelet has the correct length (minus the clasp and the final row of Honey Combs.)

My bracelet has 19 rows of 3 Honeycomb beads.
Pick up 1 HC and pass through the second hole of the next HC (previous row), repeat this one more time.


6
Use a new $12^{\prime \prime}(30 \mathrm{~cm})$ thread to connect the clasp to your bracelet. Make sure your needle is at the right point to start (leaving the second hole of one of the HC you last added.)

Pick up 10,1 half clasp, 10 and pass through the next honeycomb. Pass back through the first hole, pass through the next HC and the first hole of the HC you started this step from. Pass a few more times through all these beads to connect the clasp real tight.

Connect the other half of the clasp on the other side of your bracelet.
